How many centenarians are living in the world?

Background

According to the **United Nations**, there were:

- 450,000 centenarians in 2015 and
- about 60% are living in high-income countries.

According to the **HMD**, in 2018, there were:

- 2,084 centenarians in Sweden, and
- 70,231 centenarians in Japan.

What do we know about the centenarian population in developing countries?


Little is known.


Why is important to know how many centenarians are living in developing countries?


Background

In Brazil, according to the official statistics there were:

- **13,571** centenarians (100+) in 1991
- **24,576** centenarians in 2000
- **24,236** centenarians in 2010







What is the size of the centenarian population in Brazil?

Objective

Estimate the number of individuals aged 100 or more between 1900 and 2010 in Brazil.

Methods and Data

The variable-r method

(Horiuchi and Preston 1988)

$${}_{5}N_{x}(t) = {}_{5}N_{y}(t)e^{-\sum_{a=y}^{x} {}_{5}r_{a}}$$

$$y = 50, 55, 60, 65$$

 $x = 100, 105, 110, 115$

Methods and Data

The variable-r method



Methods and Data


Conditional probability of surviving

- Coale and Demeny Life Tables for the period 1900 to 2010 (e_0 and e_{50}).
- Three mortality models: Kannisto, Weibull and Gompertz for 2000 and 2010 (using Brazilian mortality rates 60-80+).


Estimated number of centenarians in Brazil




Estimated number of centenarians in Brazil




Estimated number of centenarians in Brazil




Number of Centenarians Estimated *Versus* Census




Number of Centenarians Estimated *Versus* Census




Number of Centenarians Estimated *Versus* Census



Number of Centenarians in Brazil





There was virtually no centenarian in Brazil in the first 2 decades of the 20th century.

Only in 2010 the number of centenarians surpassed 1,000 individuals.

There is an extensive overenumeration of centenarians in the census records.

Limitations

We had to borrow mortality patterns from other countries.

Age-specific growth rates may vary over time due to changes in census data quality.
